

He's influenced generations of researchers, mental health professionals, lawyers, judges, school systems, families, and children. The Peter Jaffe Lectures on Ending Domestic Violence takes place annually and invites an anti-violence researcher to present a public lecture on their research.




And, this year, there were 19 fewer women killed in Ontario than in the year before.

Gen Z men are less likely than older men to say they are feminist or support women's rights



Gen Z has a large gender divide on women's rights and a declining level of support among young men, compared to older men, for those rights.


